Background

INR is a specific measure of the level of anticoagulation from coumarin therapy (most common drug being Warfarin)

When to test

- When monitoring Coumarin Therapy
- Secondary care may use as part of prognostic scores for liver damage

When not to test

• Outside of Coumarin monitoring an INR should not be checked.

When to repeat a test

As part of Coumarin therapy monitoring
